## PACKING LIST



### CLOTHING

- Training gear: overalls, helmet, gloves, and boots.
- Any course-specific equipment (as instructed by the course leader).
- Enough warm clothes – be prepared for a changing weather!
- Sweatpants or casual clothes (something comfortable) and sneakers.
- Disco gear.
- Swimsuit, towel, and shower/beach sandals.
- Cap, scarf, or other headwear to protect against the sun.
- Rain gear (and rubber boots).
- Change of clothes and spare clothes + spare shoes (T-shirt, socks, and underwear – a separate set for each day!)
- Pajamas.
- Wool socks.
- It's a good idea to pack at least one set of clothes in a waterproof bag so that if your gear gets wet, you'll have at least one dry set.

### IMPORTANT AND NECESSARY

- Sleeping bag and pillow (sheet, duvet cover, or pillowcase if desired).
- Sleeping pad or camp bed; please follow the fire department's specific instructions.
- Eating utensils: plate, mug, cutlery, dish towel, and a bag for your utensils (a cloth bag is the best). Prefer plastic, easy-to-carry camping dishes.
- Toiletries and other hygiene items (e.g., toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, deodorant, etc.).
- Medical Insurance Card and necessary medications (note! See the camp doctor's instructions for packing and storing medications on [the camp website](#)).
- Red training notebook (if used by the fire brigade).

- Water bottle (and a spare).
- Phone charger and backup power source (power bank). It's a good idea to label your own chargers.
- Notetaking supplies, i.e., a pen, eraser, and notebook, as well as a writing pad or folder.
- A “daypack” to conveniently carry everything you need.
- Sunscreen.
- Blister plasters.
- Flashlight/headlamp.
- Accepted payment methods at camp include the CoreGo wristband, card, and cash. We primarily recommend CoreGo or card payments. If a young person is carrying cash, we recommend small bills and coins.

## OTHER NICE THINGS

- Insect repellent.
- Folding chair.
- Lip balm.
- Earplugs, sleep mask, stuffed animal.
- Headphones.
- Reading material, playing cards, Uno, Skip-Bo, Yahtzee, etc.
