

Checklist for a Responsible Visitors' Day

Camp participants:

- ☐ Make sure your families are informed about Visitors' Day
- ☐ Remember to keep your own sleeping areas and tent sites clean and tidy
- ☐ Put rubbish in the bins, return bottles to the camp canteen, and make sure you are ready for Visitors' Day
- ☐ Take care of everyone in your fire brigade group, especially those who are not receiving visitors
- ☐ Take time to explore the interesting activities and attractions available during Visitors' Day

If your fire brigade group has extra time during Visitors' Day, do something together. You represent the camp on Visitors' Day as well, so act as a role model and behave politely and responsibly.

Visitors:

- ☐ Familiarize yourself with the camp's information and instructions regarding Visitors' Day in advance.
- ☐ Please leave pets at home.
- ☐ Travel responsibly and use shared transportation or public transport whenever possible.
- ☐ Be prepared for changing weather conditions and remember to pack a little patience as well.
- ☐ Follow the instructions provided and do not hesitate to ask for help – the campers will be happy to assist you.
- ☐ Visitors' Day is a unique experience that is best enjoyed to the fullest.
- ☐ Enjoy the camp's activities, services, and other offerings.
- ☐ Have a pleasant and safe day, and please be considerate of others.
- ☐ Help keep the camp area clean and tidy together with everyone else.
- ☐ Help us reduce food waste and the amount of waste generated.
- ☐ We are happy that you are coming to visit your young person and support them through the final days of camp.
